## **Suspect, age 15, Deceased after Fleeing in a Stolen Car from Police Results in Fatal Crash**

Toledo, OH (March 22, 2021): Nasir Islam, a 15 year old male, is deceased and two other male juveniles, Delano Winters, age 15, and Ronnie Davis, age 14, were injured, after fleeing in a stolen vehicle from Toledo Police Officers that resulted in a fatal accident Saturday Night.

At approximately 9:17 p.m. on March 20, 2021, a Toledo Police Field Operations Crew was stopped in traffic at the red light southbound on Collingwood Boulevard at Monroe Street. While stopped at the light, a 2006 Lincoln Continental driven by Mr. Islam traveling in the left turn lane passed officers and other stopped vehicles, ran the red light, turned right, and continued northwest on Monroe Street. Officers immediately proceeded onto Monroe Street to stop the vehicle for the traffic violation. The suspect vehicle then veered left striking the center median near the front of the Toledo Museum of Art. Officers then activated their emergency lights and sirens to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle; however, the vehicle failed to comply and began to flee northwest on Monroe Street. The suspect continued on Monroe Street running the red light at the intersection with W. Bancroft Street. As Mr. Islam made a left turn onto W. Bancroft Street, he lost control of the vehicle and crashed near the intersection of W. Bancroft Street and Monroe Street. Officers approached the vehicle, assessed the condition of the



occupants, and ordered medical assistance from the Toledo Fire and Rescue Department. TFRD personnel arrived and began treating Mr. Islam, who had to be extracted from the vehicle, and the passengers, Mr. Winters and Mr. Davis.

All three occupants were then transported to an area hospital by Life Squad where Mr. Islam was pronounced deceased.

Further investigation into the incident found that the vehicle driven by Mr. Islam was stolen. As with all vehicle pursuits, this incident will be reviewed by the involved officers' command according with Toledo Police Department Policy and procedure.
