Goal 1: Improve Community Safety

Objectives:

- **Decrease Call for Service Wait Times**
Provide better service to the community by getting officers to calls for service sooner. This will reduce the likelihood of violence and increase opportunities to hold offenders responsible for the crimes they commit.
- **Expand the Drone First Responder (DFR) to full time operation**
A fully staffed DFR program can help reduce response times, provide information to responding officers, result in significant reductions in officer risk through improved situational awareness, enhanced evidence recovery, and reduced search times.
- **Increase Gun Seizures**
Increase gun seizures by 5% over 2025 levels.

Goal 2: Increase Efficiency

Objectives:

- **Increase Drone Operators**
Increase the number of drone operators by 10%.
- **Reduce Phone Backlog in Digital Forensics**
Reduce the phone backlog in Digital Forensics by 5%, compared to 2025 levels. Reductions in processing times can lead to quicker investigations and prosecution of offenders.

Goal 3: Build Trust by Supporting Officer Efforts and Community Needs

Objectives:

- **Upgrade Officer Body Cameras**
This will help build transparency with the community and modernize our technology by adding new features and improving reliability.
- **Revise employee evaluation system to provide better feedback to employees**
We will provide focused feedback and coaching to our employees to ensure optimal service to the community
- **Develop a plan to improve the department property management system**
Specifically, we will identify additional space to improve the storage of seized property, which will improve accountability, tracking, and overall management of items.
